

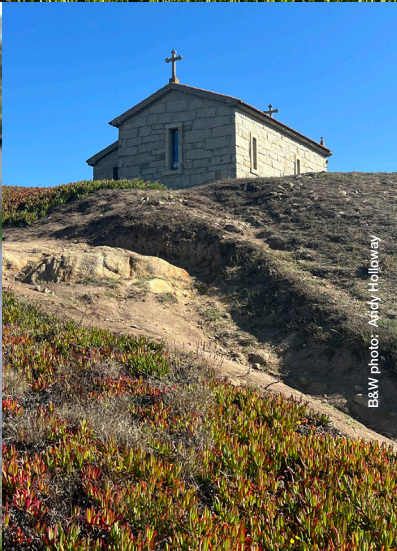

How much does it cost to secure a spot?

\$1,000 Australian dollars; US\$625; €600; £500.

How do I pay?

Go to danmullinsmusic.com and follow the prompts.

When is it?

12-25 September 2025.

How many people will be going?

50. Plus Dan.

That’s a lot of money! Where will it all go?

Dan is undertaking a tour of North America in 2026, hoping to visit as many American pilgrims as he can. Funds raised will go to flights, accommodation, production and logistics.

Will Dan be booking my accommodation?

No. The onus will be on individual pilgrims to book their own accommodation. You don’t want Dan responsible for where you end up sleeping. You may end up in a park.

Will Dan be organising food/catering?

No. The onus will be on individual pilgrims to organise their own meals. Many of the venues Dan will be performing at will have meals.

What towns will we visit?

We are starting in Porto, Portugal. A detailed itinerary will be sent to you when you confirm your spot.

Where will Dan be performing?

While venues are still being finalised, your itinerary will list the towns where shows will be held, and days when there will be no show (or at least no formal show).

What does my money get me?

The chance to laugh, cry, sing, dance and celebrate life. A ticket to more than a dozen live concerts in Portugal and Spain. Some of the most exhilarating and exciting performances you will see, alongside new friends you’ll make for life.

Who else is walking?

There will be quite a few Australians. There will be members of Dan’s family and friends. And pilgrims from all over the world.

What happens when we get to Santiago?

We are still working on the venue for the final night’s show, but you can be assured it will be a night to remember.
